# **Story Cubes in the Classroom**

Students can create cubes by writing words or drawing pictures on the sides to utilize in class with a variety of applications.

Below are some possible ideas for uses in your classes...

## Art:

- 1. Historical figures—Cube 1: name of figure, Cube 2: review/ instruction words (important dates, contribution, significant relatives, birthplace...)
- 2. Periods or movements—names of period, roll and explain or give examples

### **Career Tech:**

- 1. Terms review—roll to review terms as they apply to a unit
- 2. Steps review—cube can contain pictures to illustrate steps in a process for students to explain or put in a correct order

#### English:

- 1. Story cubes—make a story with pictures of nouns or verbs
- 2. Character review cubes—Cube 1: names of characters, Cube 2: review/instruction words (adjective, motives...)
- 3. Terms review—roll to review terms as they apply to a literary work

# Health/ PE:

- 1. Terms review—roll to review terms as they apply to a unit
- 2. Steps review—cube can contain pictures to illustrate steps in a process for students to explain or put in a correct order

#### Math:

- 1. Create problems—Cube 1: operations and parenthesis, Cube 2: numbers
- 2. Word problems—create word problems with pictures (of items?)
- 3. Formula review—names of formulas, roll and explain/write it correctly

#### Science:

- 1. Experimental design—variable measured, variable changed
- 2. Theory/ formula review—names of formulas, roll and explain/ write it correctly

#### **Social Studies:**

- 1. Historical figures—Cube 1: name of figure, Cube 2: review/ instruction words (important dates, contribution, significant relatives, birthplace...)
- 2. Terms review—roll to review terms as they apply to a historical period

### **World Language:**

- 1. Story cubes—make a story with pictures of nouns or verbs (ones they know!)
- 2. Terms review—roll to review terms as they apply to a historical period or culture
